Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Inc., the first collegiate Greek letter organization for black women in America, was founded in 1908 at Howard University in the Nation's capital. The sorority's present membership includes sorors in over 750 chapters in 44 states, Nassau, Bahamas, St. Croix, Virgin Islands, Europe, Asia, and South Africa.

Scholarships are offered to 12th grade students graduating from a **Philadelphia High School, Charter High School or Catholic High School** who plan to attend a four (4) year college or university. Last year over \$20,000 in scholarships were awarded.

The annual scholarship application is from January 1, to April 1, 2020. All entries must be postmarked no later than April 1, 2020 and should be mailed to the Application Committee Chairman:

Scholarship applications are judged by the following criteria: academic scholarship, extra-curricular activities, community involvement, quality of applicant's typed essay, and submission of all items requested on Page 4 of the application.

Semi-finalists will be chosen after our initial review of submitted applications. A *mandatory interview* will be held. Our semi-finalists will be given the date, time, and place. ***Scholarship winners will be notified by May 8, 2020.***

The scholarship winners will be honored at an awards ceremony.
